### Changing the Colour of a Car

- 1- Open the images 'Aston Martin' and 'Sky'.
- 2- Reverse the image car image left to right (image>rotate canvas>flip horizontal).
- 3- Extend the dimensions of the canvas to make room for some sky (image>canvas size), 4cm at the top should be adequate. Rename the background layer 'Car'.
- 4- Using the image 'sky', select the move tool and click and drag it into the 'Aston Martin' document. Place the sky layer below the car layer.
- 5- Select and delete the opaque white rectangle on the car layer.
- 6- Extend the foliage of the hedge into the sky area to create a more realistic hedge top (select the clone stamp tool with an appropriate brush and use it in conjunction with the Alt key as demonstrated).
- 7- Isolate the car from the background using (Lasso Tool & Quick Mask). The objective is to change just the colour of the paintwork of the car without affecting anything else, the windscreen or chrome for example.
- 8- Modify the colour (Image>Adjust>Hue & Saturation) to radically change the appearance of the paintwork. Revue the accuracy of your work and make any adjustments necessary.
- 9- Place your name in a suitable place on the image. When you are satisfied with all picture elements merge layers and print.
